(AUTHOR/ FOUNDER/ SETTLOR).

Whereas the above Author has created a Corpus Fund of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) the benefit of "VISWA BHARATA GNANA JYOTHI TRUST".

AND WHEREAS to propagate of education, health, charity for the needy and learning should aim at the betterment and rehabilitation of the recipients of the education/health/Food facilities with a view to better their economic living conditions and to stimulate them to greater effort and self-reliance rather than receive the aid as a kind which might discourage positive action, by taught to earn their Livelihood through, trades or handicrafts or service and simultaneously work for educational/health and moral regeneration.

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

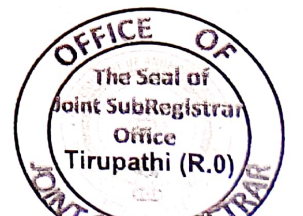

3. OFFICE OF THE TRUST: The Principal Office of the Trust shall be #D. No: 22-125, 6th cross, Srinagar colony, Avilala(P), Tirupathi Rural (M), Tirupathi (Dist)-517507, A.P, The trust shall have activities throughout the country. And also shall establish office (s) or location (s) of charity at such other place or places as the trustees may deem fit from time to time.

If the trustees feel that for carrying out and furthering the objectives of the trust more efficiently and economically the principal office of the trust is to be shifted to some other place as the trustees deem fit.

4. OBJECTIVES OF THE TRUST:

- 1) To undertake and Re-construct Road, to plants, Shelters for shelter less, Pure & Safe Drinking Water Facilities, Rural Sanitation, Rural Development and other developmental works.
- 2) To promote basic needs to the all students who are studying in the Govt School & other colleges irrespective of Caste, Creed, Religion or Sex like Purified Drinking Water, Books, uniforms, and scholarship or provide financial aid to poor / meritorious students in the field of education
- 3) To promote, establish, run, develop and manage schools, colleges, Technical Institutions, library, coaching centers etc.
- 4) To Conduct Yoga Camps, Yoga Championships, Yoga Seminars, Yoga Clinic, Yoga Workshops and other Yoga contests.
- 5) The Trust aims to Provide and organize Self Employment/ Vocational training Programmes which includes Tailoring, Handicrafts, Computers, Cot/Hand Embroidery, Jute Products/latest Innovative Technologies etc, for Urban/Rural Disadvantage Women and Youth. To awareness Rural and Urban women Thrift and Credit activates
- 6) To undertake human resource development programmes, including computer, literacy, education in information technology, training and pre -examination coaching / Training for any category or jobs whether in public sector or private to harness the target groups
- 7) To organize conferences, seminars, workshops, study circles etc. in the areas like community development, adult education, community Health, and education, counseling environment notation, agriculture Development and power conservation.

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- 8) To devise ways and means and provide facilities for the candidates to specialize in the above subjects by establishing and maintaining Hostels Libraries and lesions with the official and the non-official bodies.
- 9) To establish maintain old age homes, rehabilitation centers, Children's homes, short stay homes, family counseling centers for the poor.
- 10) Rural development through Agriculture awareness for Bio fertilizers, Medicinal Plants/ Water harvesting Bio Technology/ Science & Technology Programmes. Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development
- 11) To help people by way of providing general Medical-Checkup Medicines, Blood Donation Camps, Eye Camps, Organ Donation Awareness camps, Cancer Awareness Camps To provide mobile dispensaries giving free medicine.
- 12) The society aims at Protecting and promoting the welfare of the victims of natural calamities
- 13) To bring public awareness in health aspects by educating hygiene and sanitary which will lead to support the Government programmes like 'Swachh Bharath' and other programmes
- 14) To implement donor specific projects, which are in consonance with, trust objects with an opportunity to the donors to directly participate in the implementation of the development schemes / Projects.
- 15). To donate cloths and food for roadside people. Nutritional programs for children, pregnant women and locative mothers and old age People
- 16) To collaborate with both Governmental and Non-Governmental Organizations, Trusts, charities and other bodies involved in Community development works and services.
- 17) To celebrate National & International Days.
- 18)
- 19) To conduct environmental pollution control camps in the rural and urban areas and also undertakes waste management programme.
- 20) To undertake housing programmes & clean drinking water programmes in the Rural and Urban areas.

5. TRUST FUND:

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- a) The sum of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) declared by the author of the trust forms part of the corpus fund of the trust.
- b) The proceeds of donations/grants received from the public shall be credited to the trust fund
- c) The income of the properties of the trust to be purchased and sale proceeds of any property of the trust sold and income for the permitted activity if any shall be credited to the trust fund.
- d) The trust sum shall be invested in such manner as indicated in Indian Trust Act, 1982 read in conjunction with Sec. 13 (1) (d) read with Sec. 11 (5) Income Tax Act, 1961.

6. CEASURE OF MEMBERSHIP:

It shall be on the following grounds.

- a. By death.
- b. By becoming insane.
- c. By resignation in writing subject to the acceptance of the managing committee.
- d. By indulging in any activity that mars the dignity, prestige and decorum of the society.
- e. By failing to attend three meetings consecutively.
- f. By conviction of a court of law

7. MANAGEMENT

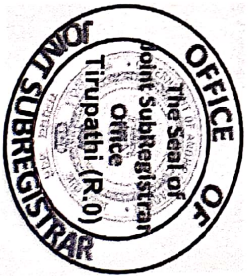
1. The Management and control of the properties that may be acquired by the TRUST and affairs of the TRUST shall be vested in the BOARD OF TRUSTEES consisting of the FIRST TRUSTEES above named. The TRUSTEES for the time being may nominate or appoint from time to time such other persons, who in the opinion of the TRUSTEES are fit and suitable to be considered for membership of the BOARD OF TRUSTEES as additional TRUSTEES.
2. The total number of TRUSTEES shall not exceed 7 at any time. However the BOARD OF TRUSTEES shall always have a MINIMUM NUMBER OF 2 PERSONS AS TRUSTEES.
3. THE FIRST TRUSTEES shall be the TRUSTEES for life time they shall be entitled to nominate in writing and addressed to the TRUST a person to succeed them to the OFFICE OF TRUSTEES in the event of a vacancy arising by reason of death, resignation or any other cause whatsoever. They shall also be entitled to cancel or vary such nominations from time to time. They shall also be entitled to nominate such persons as they may desire in a testamentary paper to succeed them to the OFFICE OF THE TRUST. Such nominee on assuming office of TRUST shall be entitled to exercise all such powers and authorities as are vested in the TRUST DEED in these presents.

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4. **SmtSamalajyothione** of the FIRST TRUSTEES shall be the MANAGING TRUSTEE. The MANAGING TRUSTEE shall hold office for life time. In the event of the MANAGING TRUSTEE ceasing to hold office for any reason whatsoever, the TRUSTEES from among them may appoint a MANAGING TRUSTEE who shall hold office as such for life or for such period from the date of such appointment as the TRUSTEES may determine. He shall be entitled for reappoint as MANAGING TRUSTEE. In the absence of any appointment as MANAGING TRUSTEE, the management and control of properties that may be acquired by the TRUST shall be vested with the BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

5. The MANAGING TRUSTEE shall be responsible for the day to day administration of the affairs of the TRUST and shall have the authority to do all acts and things, and exercise all powers of the Board as may be delegated from time to time by the BOARD OF TRUSTEES and the BOARD OF TRUSTEES may also ratify any act done or powers exercised by the MANAGING TRUSTEE in fulfillment of the objects set out above.

6. The MANAGING TRUSTEE shall be the PRESIDENT of THE TRUST and shall preside over the meetings of the BOARD OF TRUSTEES and shall have a casting vote in cases contemplated in the clause hereinafter stated. **The Quorum for any meeting of the BOARD OF TRUSTEES shall be two members present in person.**

7. EVERY TRUSTEE other than the FIRST TRUSTEES or their successors or nominees shall hold office for a period of three years and shall be eligible for reappointment to the BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

8. It shall be lawful for the TRUSTEES from time to time to frame such rules and regulations for the Management and administration of the TRUST, as they shall think fit and to alter or vary the same from time to time and make new rules and regulations shall not be inconsistent with the terms and intents of these presents.

9. Every power, authority or discretion conferred upon the TRUSTEES shall be exercised or signified either by some instrument in writing or a Resolution passed by circular which is signed by the majority of the TRUSTEES or by a Resolution passed at a meeting of the TRUSTEES.

10. In case of difference of opinion arising among the TRUSTEES and in all matters wherein the TRUSTEES shall have a discretionary power, the votes of the majority of the TRUSTEES FOR THE TIME BEING VOTING in the matter shall prevail and be binding on the minority as well as on those TRUSTEES who may not have voted, and in case of equality of votes, the Chairman shall have a casting vote and the matter shall be decided according to the casting vote of the Chairman.

11. The TRUSTEES shall keep or cause to be kept a Minute Book of their proceedings and proper books of Account and the Accounts shall be audited each year by qualified Auditors.

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12. The BOARD OF TRUSTEES may delegate any of its powers to committees consisting of the MANAGING TRUSTEE or any one or more of the other TRUSTEES and eminent persons from the relevant profession, residing in India and other persons of eminence and status, for the purpose of carrying out any of the functions which may be specifically delegated to that committee in fulfillment of the objects of the TRUST. Any committee so formed shall, in exercise of the powers so delegated conform to any regulations that may be imposed on it by the Board. The BOARD OF TRUSTEES may also ratify any act done or powers exercised by such committees in fulfillment of the objects of the TRUST.
13. A TRUSTEE may at any time resign from his office as TRUSTEE by sending a registered letter addressed to the BOARD OF TRUSTEES. No vacancy in the Board of Trustees shall invalidate any act or decision of the other Trustees constituting of Board of Trustees.
14. A TRUSTEE shall be disqualified from acting as a TRUSTEE and shall be removed from such TRUSTEESHIP in any of the following circumstances.
- a) Who becomes bankrupt or Lunatic
 - b) In the event of his being convicted by the Court of Law of any offence involving a crime of moral turpitude.
 - c) If he / she is found to be of unsound mind by a Court of competent jurisdiction.
 - d) In the event of TRUSTEE acting against the interest of the TRUST.

The matter shall be placed before the Board of Trustees and such persons shall be removed from the post of Trustee by majority decision of Board of Trustees constituting of trustees.

8. FIRST CHAIRMAN AND MANAGING TRUSTEE:

Sri Samala Jyothi w/ Y.Kumaraswamy Reddy shall be the First Chairman and the Managing Trustee of the Trust for life. On his death, the person who has been nominated by the Chairman and the managing trustee to succeed him as the First Chairman and Managing Trustee, shall be the next Chairman and Managing Trustees of the Trust of Samala Jyothi w/Y.Kumaraswamy Reddy the first Chairman and Managing Trustee so desires, then she can nominate at any point of time, any other person from among the trustees to act as the Managing trustee, while he shall continue to be Chairman of the trust.

9. DUTIES OF TRUST MEMBERS:

I. FIRST PRESIDENT, FOUNDER AND MANAGING TRUSTEE:

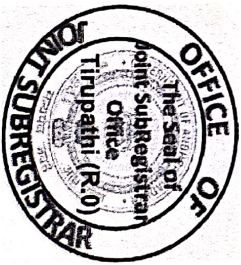
- a) To have the full control over the assets of the Trust.
- b) To draw make accept, endorse, discount, negotiate, execute, cheques and bill of exchange and other negotiable instruments.
- c) The Managing Trustee shall have power to Sell, Donate, Charge, Mortgage any immovable property of the Trust.
- d) The Managing Trustee can delegate such works or works to other trustees which are to be done by him. The managing trustee has the power to invite of any other person for the Board meeting as an observer at any time as he wishes.
- e) To implement the projects and to have control over the office and field staff

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f) He shall operate the Bank Accounts of the Trust Independently

II. TRUSTEES:

The Trustees will have to carry the directions of the Managing Trustee from time to time.

10. MEETINGS:

- a) The General Body shall normally meet once in a year in the month of JUNE.
- b) For any emergency purposes, if the Managing committee makes the decision, the General body meeting shall be convened.
- c) For any special reasons either 50% of the General body or 1/3rd members of the Managing committee desire and request in writing to the Managing Trustee, the General body meeting shall be convened.
- d) The Executive body will meet once in four months or earlier if their need for it.

11. FUNDS:

The funds of the association shall consist of the following:

- a. Membership fees
- b. Donations and contributions, Hundi collections, Kind Donations.
- c. Grants by the Central or State Govt. or other foreign donor agencies.

12. FUNDS AND THEIR UTILISATION:

The property of the Trust derived from whatever source shall always be applied towards the promotion of the objectives of the Trust, and no portion there or small be paid or utilized directly or indirectly.

13. DURATION OF TRUST:

The TRUST constituted herein shall be irrevocable and in the vent of the TRUST becoming unworkable or un operative for any reason whatsoever, the TRUSTEES shall have the power to hand over the corpus of the TRUST to one or more public charitable and or religious institutions with similar objects and duly recognized under the Income Tax Act 1961.

14. BANKERS AND ACCOUNTS:

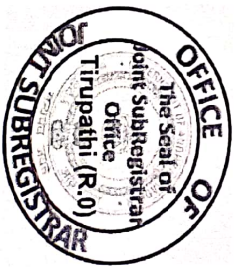
a) All the funds shall be paid into the Trust single account/ Single operation with the Nationalized banks or in any securities under Indian Trust Act and shall not be withdraw except by means of cheque signed by such officers of the association as may be duly empowered on this behalf of the executive committee single by the President. The managing trustee. The Bank Account operated by the Managing Trustee of the Trust Independently. The funds should not be misused or mismanaged.

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- b) Accounts of the association shall be audited by a chartered accountant appointed by the Trustees. The detailed managements in regard to the form of accounts their maintenance and presentation of the affair of the trust shall be decided with the auditor by the executive com.
- c) The financial year of the Trust shall April to March.

13. AMENDMENTS:

All amendments will be made after following the instructions joy down in Indian Trust Act, 1982.

14. INCOME TAX EXEMPTION ACT:

1. The funds of the institutions would be invested as per section 11 (5) of the IT Act, 1961.
2. The Institution /Trust/Society is irrevocable.
3. The accounts would be maintained regularly and would be audited by a Chartered Accountant (Explan. Sec.28/2)
4. The funds of the institution would be utilized only towards the objects and no portion of it would be distributed in any manner to the trustees or defined in section 13(1) (c) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
5. In the case of winding up dissolution the net funds would be transferred to institution having similar objects and enjoying exemption U/s 11 & 80 G of the IT Act, 1961.
6. The benefit of object would be available to the general public irrespective of Caste, Creed, Religion or Sex.
7. Any amendment to the instrument would be carried out only with the approval of the CTT- Hyderabad.
8. The charitable activities would be confined to the territory of India only.
9. The activities would be purely charitable/non-religion in nature not motivated for profit. Not more than 5% of the income of the Trust/Institution/Society would be applied for any religion purpose or given to religious institutions.

15. MISCELLANEOUS:

All meetings of the Trust, Managing committee of the General body meeting may be adjourned from time to time. But only subjects notified for the original meeting alone shall be transacted at the adjourned meeting.

16. GENERAL:

For all things not specially provide for under the Rules and Regulations the provisions of the Indian Trust Act, 1982 will apply.

17. WINDING UP:

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If any reason the Trust has to be closed the properties of the Trust will not be distributed to the members of the Trust, but on the other hand there properties will be given to any other similar Trust which has the same aims and objectives.

18. DECLARATION:

There is no movable property and any immovable property is in the name of the Trust on the execution of the deed.



Through this Trust Deed no moveable properties have been transferred in Favor of "VISWA BHARATA GNANA YOTHI TRUST".
